Practical Test Methodology

- i. Not less than 5 minutes will be given for the practical test.**
- ii. The maximum marks that can be obtained in the practical test is twenty-five (25).**
- iii. A minimum of 2 marks must be obtained for each criteria to pass the practical test.**
- iv. The evaluation of the practical test will be done by an interview panel appointed by the Secretary, Ministry of Education - Central Province.**

Purpose of criteria

- i. Purpose and access**
Successfully explain the purpose of the lesson and evaluate the ability to enter into the lesson.
- ii. Personality and Voice control**
Evaluation of having a good personality as a teacher and the ability to control the voice well in teaching
- iii. Clarity of communication**
Evaluate the ability to effectively communicate relevant information in the learning and teaching process.
- iv. Time management**
Evaluate the ability to achieve the objective within the given time period.
- v. Use of presentation techniques**
Ability to effectively use presentation techniques to achieve the objective.
